California here we come! The annual NFHR membership meeting and educational forum will be held February 13-16, 2015 at the George Ingalls Equestrian Center in Norco, California.

The theme of the forum is our own NFHR Evaluation Program. On Saturday and Sunday we will hold an NFHR official evaluation (forms online soon.) The forum will be held on Friday and Monday.

Thursday, Feb. 12 - We will start the festivities with a wine tour of the Temecula Valley Wine Country. In Norco, join fellow Norwegian Fjord lovers for a wine tour in Temecula, California on Thursday, Feb 12. Cost per person is \$130. This includes the bus cost, visits to four wineries with wine tasting flights at each one, a behind the scenes wine making tour at one winery, a gourmet style box lunch, discount for wine purchases through the day, and the required 18% gratuity for tour host and bus driver. Bus departs hotel in Norco, CA at 9am for the one-hour trip to Temecula and will return to Norco at 4 pm. The bus ride provides lots of opportunities to get to meet NFHR members and representatives of European Norwegian Fjord Horses who are planning to attend. Make your winter blahs go away in sunny southern California with a great group of Fjord lovers.

Friday, Feb. 13, 9am – This time is designated for our annual membership meeting and introduction of special guests.

Friday, Feb. 13, beginning after the meeting - This portion of the forum will cover the process and goals of our NFHR Evaluation Program and how it differs from other countries. Speakers and panelists will be some of our US evaluators and Evaluation Committee Members. There will be time for Q&A with the speakers in a panel format.

Friday Evening Feb. 13 – We will have a welcoming reception with several special guests including, Birgitte Reitan, the para dressage rider from Norway who competed in the World Equestrian Games last month riding a Norwegian Fjord horse. The reception will have a Western Theme, so wear your best duds!

Saturday and Sunday will be the actual evaluation with some educational opportunities about the "hows" and "whys" of what is going on. Registration forms for the evaluation are available on the website.

Monday our Norwegian guests will speak and we will have a chance for Q&A with a panel of our speakers and a wrap up of the evaluation process.
