ALL ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY July 21, 2020 IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE.

To be eligible for Evaluation, a Fjord must:

- Be owned by a current NFHR member.
- Be registered with the NFHR.
- Have been DNA typed (geldings included).
- Be microchipped and recorded with the NFHR (No microchipping or DNA typing will be done at the Evaluation site.)
- Have a current (within 30 days) Veterinarian Health Certificate.
- Have a negative (within one year of eval date) Coggins report.

LOCATION:

The September 2020 Midwest NFHR Evaluation will be held at Belinda's Best Little Horse House, 28204 560th Ave, Cambridge, IA 50046. The entrance to the facility is located at 56124 280th St. Signs will indicate the route.

DIRECTIONS:

Evaluation location is within 5 miles from fuel, lodging, Walmart, Target, grocery stores, feed stores (Theisen's), and hardware stores. 2 miles further East on Prosperity will get you to a tack and saddle repair shop (Circle N Stables). There is ample parking for participants with trailers as well as spectators with cars and trucks.

From the North.

- I-35 South toward Des Moines
- At Exit #111B, take right ramp for US-30 West towards Ames
- Exit at US-69S/South Duff and turn left (south)
- Turn left onto 265th St
- Bear right at fork in road onto 560th Ave
- Turn left onto 280th St.
- Destination will be on the right (Follow Banners / Balloons to arrive at the final destination)

From the South.

- I-35 N.
- At Exit #102, take ramp right for IA-210 toward Huxley/Maxwell
- Turn left onto IA-210/HWY 210/330th St
- At Stop sign, turn right onto US-69 and follow through the town of Huxley.
- About 2 miles north of Huxley, turn right on 282nd St (gravel road)
- At end of 282nd St, turn left onto 560th. Proceed approximately quarter of a mile up to 280th St and turn right. Destination will be at the top of the hill to the right.
- Destination will be on the Right (Follow Banners / Balloons to arrive at the final destination)

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

Prior to the event, a final schedule will be emailed to all participants. Upon your arrival you will be given your entry packet. The packet will include your stall assignment, map of the area, bridle tag number and program. The Evaluation will begin Saturday morning, September 19th with conformation tests and some performance tests. The remaining Performance tests are scheduled for Sunday, September 20th. The number and type of entries will determine the final schedule. Early Saturday Morning, there will be a meeting of the participants, TD and Evaluators. This is primarily an informational session to review the day's schedule and answer any questions. Format for the evaluation will be: Test, ribbon presentation and evaluator comments for that test. There will be a lunch break both days. Medallion of Quality presentation will be on Sunday, after the last performance test, ribbon presentation and evaluator comments are completed for that test.
