To be eligible for Evaluation, a Fjord must:

- Be owned by a current NFHR member.
- Be registered with the NFHR.
- Have been DNA typed (geldings included).
- Be microchipped and recorded with the NFHR (No microchipping or DNA typing will be done at the Evaluation site.)
- Have a current (within 30 days) Veterinarian Health Certificate.
- Have a negative (within one year of eval date) Coggins report.

## LOCATION:

The August 2022 Midwest NFHR Evaluation will be held at Jester Park Equestrian Center, 11171 NW 103 Court ,Granger, IA 50109.

## DIRECTIONS:

Evaluation location is within 5 miles from fuel, grocery stores, lodging and Hardware stores in Polk City. Additional shopping, feed stores such as Tractor Supply (Ankeny) and Bomgaars (Grimes), and lodging are located within 15 miles around the greater Des Moines area.

- Take Exit #96 toward Elkhart/Polk City
- Turn right onto NE 126<sup>th</sup> Ave
- Turn left on US-69 S
- Turn right onto NE 126<sup>th</sup> Ave
- Continue on to E Northside Dr
- Turn left onto N 3<sup>rd</sup> St
- Turn rt onto IA-415N/W Bridge Rd (continue to follow to IA-415N)
- Turn right onto State Hwy 415
- Continue on to NW 106<sup>th</sup> Ave
- Turn right on NW 107<sup>th</sup> st
- Turn right onto NW 114<sup>th</sup> Ave
- Continue on to NW103rd Ct/NW Beaver Rd.
- Destination will be ahead at the end of the parking lot (Follow Banners / Balloons to arrive at the final destination)

### SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

The packet will include your stall assignment, map of the area, bridle tag number and program. The Evaluation will begin Saturday morning, August 6th with conformation tests and some performance tests. The remaining Performance tests are scheduled for Sunday, August 7th. The number and type of entries will determine the final schedule. Early Saturday Morning, there will be a meeting of the participants, TD and Evaluators. This is primarily an informational session to

review the day's schedule and answer any questions. Format for the evaluation will be: Test, ribbon presentation and evaluator comments for that test. There will be a lunch break both days. Medallion of Quality presentation will be on Sunday, after the last performance test, ribbon presentation and evaluator comments are completed for that test.
